## IT'S TIME FOR A FACELIFT!

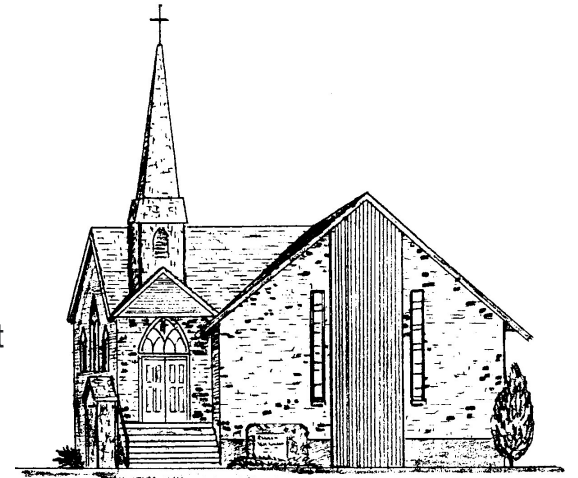
Our church needs a considerable amount of care and work. The last time we did any substantial repair was 2002.
