Key Themes

- Share your personal vision of heaven. What elements are essential for it to feel like paradise to you?

Reflection

- How can we practice seeing the face of God in our everyday lives as a way to prepare for heaven?
- Reflect on the idea that heaven begins now and continues into the next life. How does this perspective change how you view your current circumstances?
